Grant Principles

The intent of FHS Foundation funds is to be 'last in money' (expenses not able to be foreseen)

Types of grant requests to be considered:

- Grants for students at Framingham High School
- Expenses for extra-curricular activities (activities, arts & athletics)
- Broken or missing equipment
- Entrance fees
- Travel expenses, including Championship travel
- Some field trips
- Books
- Items used for extracurriculars which remain school property
- In season practice due to inclement weather

Types of grant requests which do not fit FHSF mission and are not funded:

- Grants for students at middle or elementary schools
- Individual student scholarships
- Individualized clothing for students (e.g., jackets with their last name embroidered)
- Championship rings kept by the students
- Prizes/gift cards
- Stipends/portions of Salaries
- Any activities fundraising for other 501(c)3s
- Off season practice expenses
